CMCT November Update

Years 11, 12 and 13 in High School in India finally opened for classes in October. Then the younger children all returned to school on Monday November 1. They have been out of school for a whole year and a half so this is massive. There are probably millions of happy kids all over India and very relieved parents (along with the anxiety that comes with opening up again.) Churches also reopened in India at the end of October.

Just yesterday morning we heard from CMCT that there is serious flooding in Chennai. From Saturday it has been raining heavily in city. Since all the reservoirs are full they have now opened the flood gates which has caused flooding in the city and many roads and homes are under water. It is expected to rain heavily for the next few days and all the schools and colleges are closed now. Many of the homes of the CMCT staff are flooded with water. It seems like they don't get a break! Once again, thanks for all your support in so many ways.
