We received a letter from CMCT this week and felt a need to respond.

"Our programme department staff are very busy distributing ration bags to people in need in remote villages. They obtained a list of people living in each village and have made sure everyone gets a bag. Each bag contains rice, dhal, sugar, one oil pack, sooji and wheat flour packets, and two vermicilli packets. Along with this we give a strip of zinc and vitamin C tablets, a pair of masks and a sanitizer bottle. Distribution will continue to cover all the needy villages and slums in the city. The staff leave early in the morning as it is a long drive to these villages. It makes a tiring day but it is a joy to see their smiling faces."
